LAND BASE SOURCES OF POLLUTION COLLAGE COMPETITION (LBS)

BACKGROUND

In celebration of the entry into force of the Protocol concerning pollution from Land-Based Sources and Activities (LBS), UNEP's Caribbean Environment Programme (CEP) has officially launched the Wider Caribbean LBS Protocol Collage Competition. The local leg of the competition will be facilitated by Caribbean Youth Environment Network St. Vincent and the Grenadines Chapter (CYEN-SVG).

COMPETITION THEME

The theme for the collage competition is "[A Future that is Pollution Free - Join Hands to Protect our Caribbean Sea](#)" The theme for the competition focuses on our beautiful Caribbean Sea, and how we can protect its fragile, vulnerable coastal and marine ecosystems from land-based sources of pollution.

What is a Collage

Collage refers to a technique of composing a work of art by pasting on a single surface various materials not normally associated with one another, such as magazine clippings, parts of photographs, packaging, paintings, solid objects, etc.

COMPETITION RULES

Participants must be between the ages of 12-18 years old and must enter through their school/class environmental club, faith-based group and/or other community or youth organization.

The closing date for entries is June 30th 2011.

Participants should be creative, collage of any sizes and styles is acceptable,

Full name, of group, full address including phone and e-mail must be on the back of the collage or on an accompanying paper.

Only hard copies of art work will be accepted (E-mail entries will only be accepted after hard copies are received)

Entries should reach Yoland London at the Ministry of National Mobilization, Community Development division no later than 4pm Thursday June 30th

The 1st place will receive \$500.00 EC

The 1st, 2nd and third place entries will be eligible to represent St. Vincent and the Grenadines in the Regional Competition to vie for cash prizes of US\$1000.00 (First Prize), US\$750.00 (Second Prize) or US\$500.00 (Third Prize).

The winning collage for the region will be converted into a portable banner and used in UNEP's promotional campaigns on the LBS Protocol and more
